Redefine the Art of Fire with the Ambiance

New at Northwest Stoves, the Ambiance and Ambiance "Mini" Table Top Fire Features. These 2 visually stunning products can be the focal point of your outdoor entertaining area. When friends and family gather, let the Ambiance be the conversation starter with its safe, clean-burning flame.



At 42,000 BTU's, the 92.5" tall Ambiance (seen on the left of this page) delivers a majestic "Ambi-Fire" flame through a 4" diameter, commercial grade borosilicate glass quartz tube. The Pyromid ceramic burner uses LP gas from a 20 lb. tank as its fuel source.

Side panel options include Stainless Steel and Antique Bronze, and the side supports are made from extruded aluminum.

The Ambiance is CSA approved and comes with a one year residential warranty and a 120 day commercial warranty.

At just 34" in height, the Ambiance Mini has just the right hypnotic glow to be a fantastic talking point on its own. Using a standard 16 oz. propane cylinder, the Mini is completely self-contained and will run up to 2.5 hours while on its high setting—longer if turned down to a lower flame height—and is the perfect patio table complement.

The Mini (seen on the right) comes standard with a 'tip-switch' which shuts the unit off automatically should it be knocked over, comes in Stainless Steel and is CSA approved.

The Ambiance in Antique Bronze retails for \$799 and in Stainless Steel for \$899. The Mini lists for just \$299, Both are available today!

Pacific Energy Trenton DV Stove

Coming soon from Pacific Energy, the Trenton Gas Stove is an exceptional performer with classic good looks. Heavy cast iron radiates the heat evenly from the top and sides of the stove, providing constant heat throughout the room. Decorative doors swing open to reveal an unobstructed window of the rich, full flames and stacked logset. The fire is even further reflected across the lustrous porcelain black panels that line the interior of the firebox and enhancing the flames.



Trenton in Majolica Brown

Available in matte black paint, Majolica Brown enamel and Antique White enamel, the Trenton will suit any décor.

The Trenton has IPI ignition using a SIT Proflame 2 valve, comes standard with a remote control, 2—80 CFM blowers and accent floor lighting. With a P4 rating of 74.4%, the Trenton is approved for BC's Fortis rebate. It is a versatile rear vent stove and can go as far as 4' to a horizontal termination before any rise is required, making the Trenton a very viable option in many installations.

The Trenton will be available very soon and in matte black will retail for \$2199 and both of the enamel units for just \$2699.

Neo 1.6 Wood Stove—a User Report by Clinton Tod

Clinton Tod—NWS sales rep and technical support—took home a NEO 1.6 wood stove from PE to try. He lives in a medium sized home in Greater Vancouver. Here is his report:

Officially, this unit wins the "Most fires I've had in any unit at my house" award. Let's think about what this says. Much like Goldilocks' findings in the three bears house, this one's just right.

Style wise, it's was also the best suited so far to what I think works well in my basement. It's a European style (tall and smaller footprint) stove. I liked how high the firebox is off the floor. I liked the ease of loading, and how you can see the secondary combustion from across the room. It's modern, trendy, and sleek.

I had approximately 200 fires in the unit. Typically on weekdays I would light a fire when I came home, and let it go out. On weekends, I would light a fire in the morning, and a second in the evening if it was cold. I had poor wood (a lot of cedar) and would still get 4 - 6 hours of heat. This method did not heat my entire home but did work well for heating the space that the unit was installed in very comfortably. The only time it was uncomfortable was when I re-stoked the fire to try and cheat the system a little and not restart the fire from scratch.

For selling the unit from a heating standpoint it's just like any other smaller unit. It's good for heating a space, not a large home. If your home was 1000 square feet with adequate insulation it would do a good job. I never had an issue with heat output. The glass fogged up, but as it has a typical PE air wash it didn't take much to burn the glass clean.

I'm a little sad to see it go, truthfully. I didn't like the way the baffle comes out, but PE has changed that. The brick rails had to come out to remove the baffle. The old style rails came out from the outside of the unit; that is, they were bolted through the firebox. The new style rails (both the sides and back) slide out inside the firebox on pegs. It's a much nicer system. The ash dump is also going to be redesigned, which is really the only thing I did not like about the unit.

To sum it up: it works great, looks good, and delivers more than I expected.


